Any student on KISWATE scholarship must demonstrate mastery of spoken Kiswahili language by the end of high school education. Video clips of beneficiaries speaking in Kiswahili when engaged in any school activity will form the basis of renewal of KISWATE scholarship / financial assistance. It is the responsibility of the beneficiary to submit such clips via whatsapp through Kiswahili teacher once every month. KISWATE CEO will visit all beneficiaries once every term to evaluate progress on academics, out of class activities and spoken Kiswahili.

All applicants for KISWATE Scholarship fund must participate in KISWATE Talent show once every year to empower them to communicate effectively in English, Kiswahili and the local language of the people in the community where the school is domiciled.


